
Bethanne Nemesh

Class description: A 4-hour hands-on machine quilting class, you bring your own domestic sewing machine. Cost: \$40 / \$41 Venmo



Class description: A two-hour drawing class - no machine needed. Cost: \$20 / \$20.50 Venmo)

"Knowing how to freehand quilt a variety of floral motifs, without marking, in a variety of settings, is one of the most flexible skills a quilter can have. Eliminating dependence on stencils, robotics, or excessive planning is one of the keys to quick, pragmatic, yet beautiful quilting designs."
