Quilts for Kids is a nonprofit organization dedicated to transforming fabrics into patchwork quilts to comfort children facing serious illness, trauma, abuse, and natural disasters.

To test the pattern, I chose a black and white fish print accented with primary colors. For the borders I used a donated print we have TONS of, black background with tiny green frogs.

It cuts out fast and sews up easily. It is a good pattern to try if you want practice measuring borders correctly to get a quilt to lay flat.

Materials:

- 2 – 2 1/2” WOF strips color A for 4 patch blocks
- 2 – 2 1/2” WOF strips color B for 4 patch blocks
- 3 – 8 1/2” WOF strips of print fabric
- 2” strips for sashing
- 3 1/2” strips for borders

Quilt will measure approximately: 38 1/2” wide by 44 1/2” long
